

# Reporting unusual signs of disease or death in school farm animals

- Ulcers or blisters present.
- Skin nodules (especially cattle).
- Unexplained and significant increased in mortality (death) rate.
- Unexplained and significant increase in morbidity (illness) rate.
- Unexplained and significant fall in production.
- Appearance of other unusual signs of disease, including neurological signs or conditions (tremors, seizures, recumbency, paddling).
